



By Virtue of a Warrant of Resurvey bearing date the 16th day of August 1783 there was Resurveyed on the 19th day of September 1783 for Hugh Lennox the above described two Tracts of land, the first of which is part of a larger tract originally Surveyed by Virtue of a Warrant granted to James Cole dated the 11th of 10th Month 1719 which part contains 115^{3/4} 95 23 P & allowance, the latter is part of a tract originally surveyd in pursuance of a Warrant to Thomas Cochran dated 12th of January 1737 which part contains 123 95 13 P & allowance at the rate of six per cent both of which are Situate in Oxford Township in the County of Chester. Containing in both 238 95 3/4 ~~36 per cent~~ & allowance of six P. Cent.
