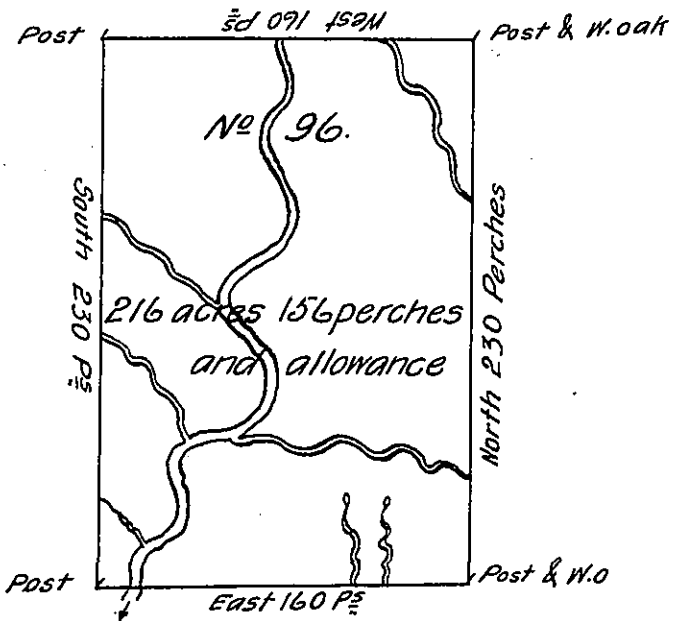

In Pursuance of an Act of Assembly Passed the  
 12<sup>th</sup> day of March 1783 for the Sale of Certain lands therein mentioned  
 and by Virtue of a Commiss<sup>n</sup> under the hand and seal of Office from John  
 Lukens Esquire Surveyor Gen<sup>l</sup> for the State of Pennsylvania bearing date at  
 Philadelphia the 22<sup>nd</sup> day of August 1783. The above tract of land contain-  
 ing two hundred and sixteen acres and 156 perches and allowance of 6 P Cent  
 for Roads &c. Was surveyed on the 25<sup>th</sup> day of June 1785 by
