



The above Draught represents a piece of land in Drumore Township Lancaster County. Containing 3 Acres and the usual allowance of 6 pr. Cent for roads &c. Being part of 3 A.S. 103 p 5 & allowance. Surveyed March 16<sup>th</sup> 1837 in pursuance of a Warrant dated December 21<sup>st</sup> A.D. 1836 granted to Robert Henry Long which survey was not accepted because containing an excess of land. Now Resurveyed in pursuance of said Warrant for Samuel Seiple who holds the same in right of the said Robert Henry Long February 14<sup>th</sup> 1860.
