



Dikeate in Frankstown Township Blair County Pa. Surveyed and returned in the first place in pursuance of a warrant dated 28th February A.D. 1851. to Joseph Kemp, for twenty six acres, and afterward found to be located on wrong ground. On application of the said Kemp, the Board of Property by an order dated the 28th day of June A.D. 1856. granted and ordered a change of location of resurvey. And in pursuance of said order on the 16th day of July A.D. 1856. the present resurvey was made, containing twenty five acres, one hundred and sixty one perches, and allowance of six per cent &c.
