



The above diagram describes a small tract of Land situate in Delaware Township Juniata County, Containing six acres and one hundred and forty five perches, Now owned by the Heirs of Isaac Winey, now surveyed for partitioning the same, it being a part of a larger tract the greater part of which is situated in Perry County, Greenwood Township, Originally surveyed on a warrant to John C. Leffman, dated the 24<sup>th</sup> day of May, 1841, Containing thirty two acres and four perches, the balance of which is described by dotted lines.
