


Situate in York Township in the County of York, Containing as above set forth 84^{as} 48^{cs} 8^{cs} perches and allowance of Being part of a larger tract of land which was originally surveyed in pursuance of a warrant to agree for 300^{as} granted to Conrad Curta dated the 16th day of January 1767. Resurveyed and a piece of vacant land added (by order of the Board of Property dated the 17th December 1812, to Eleanor Gartner) the 31st day of March, 1813. The above part Resurveyed and divided of from the said larger tract of land the 31st day of October, 1827 for George Lievenstone, the present owner, at whose request the same is returned for Confirmation
