 ance of a warrant granted to Frederick Brauss, dated the 10<sup>th</sup> day  
 of May A.D. 1859 for 140<sup>acs</sup>. Re-examined the 22<sup>d</sup> day of September A.D.  
 1868. and found correct. Interest to commence the 1<sup>st</sup> day of  
 March A.D. 1842
