



A draught of a lot of ground in the town of Carlisle in the County of Cumberland marked in a general plan of said Town No. 219 situate on the north side of Pomfret street between Hanover Street & Bedford street, containing in breadth East and West sixty feet and in length North and South Two hundred and forty feet bounded Southward with Pomfret Street, Eastward with Lot No. 227, Northward with a Twenty feet Alley and westward with Lot No. 211 granted to John Montgomery & others by Warrant 1st March 1773. in trust for erecting & building a Grammar School thereon
