



A draught of a Lot of Ground in the Town of Carlisle in the County of Cumberland, marked in a General Plan of said town Number 221. Situate on the North side of High Street, and westward of Bedford Street, containing in breadth East and West sixty feet and in length North and South two hundred and forty feet. Bounded Southward with High Street aforesaid, Westward with Lot No. 213 Northward with a twenty feet Alley, and Eastward with Lot No. 229. Returned into the Secretarys Office, the 23^d day of April, 1772 by Warrant dated the 22^d Instant granted to Ruth M^c Cooney
