



A Draught of a lot of ground in the Town of Carlisle in the County of Cumberland marked in a general plan of said Town No 220 situate on the south side of High Street between the Center Square and Bedford Street containing in Breadth East and West on High Street sixty feet and in Length North and South two Hundred and forty feet, bounded Northward with High Street Eastward with Lot No 228 Southward with a twenty feet alley and Westward with Lot No 212 Returned into the Secretary's Office the 12th Day of June 1772 by Warrant ^{granted} of the same Date to William Lyon.
