



In pursuance of an Order from the Commissioner of Prop-  
 erty dated the 16<sup>th</sup> of June 1772 a survey was made on the 3<sup>d</sup> of July  
 following of a certain Lot of Ground in the Town of Sunbury in the  
 County of Northumberland, being numbered in the general Plan  
 of said Town, Two, and granted to Jesse Lukens containing in Bread-  
 -th East and West sixty feet and in length North and South Two hund-  
 -red and thirty feet, Bounded Westward by lot number Sixty six,  
 Southward by Shamokin Street, Eastward by the Public square and  
 Lot number Three and Northward by Mulberry Alley, as by the  
 general plan of said Town remaining in the Surveyor General's office  
 will appear.
