



In Pursuance of an Order from the Commissioner of Property dated the 16th day of June 1772 a Survey was made on the 3^d day of July following for George Ross Junr of the County of Lancaster on a certain Lot of ground in the Town of Sunbury in the County of Northumberland marked in a general Plan of said Town Number One hundred and Seventy four Containing in Breadth East and West on the North side of Blackberry Street Sixty feet & in Length North and South Two hundred and Thirty feet, Bounded Southward by Blackberry Street aforesaid, Eastward by Lot Number One hundred and Seventy three Northward by Barberrry Alley and Westward by Lot Number One hundred and Seventy five. Returned into the Secretary's Office the 13th day of August 1774 for Lodowick Ligget by Warrant dated the 12th August Instant

IN TESTIMONY that the above is a copy of the original remaining on file in the Department of Internal Affairs of Pennsylvania, made conformably to an Act of Assembly approved the 16th day of February, 1833, I have hereunto set my Hand and caused the Seal of said Department to be affixed at Harrisburg, this sixth day of August 1905.
