



In Pursuance of an Order from the Commissioner of Property dated the 16th day of June 1772 a Survey was made on the 3^d day of July following for David McConaughy on a certain lot of Ground situate in the Town of Sunbury in the County of Northumberland and marked in a general Plan of said Town. Number Two hundred and forty seven. Containing in Breadth East and West on Poakberry Street Sixty feet and in Length North and South Two hundred and Thirty feet, Bounded Northward by Poakberry Street aforesaid, Westward by Lot Number Two hundred and forty Eight, Southward by Raspberry Alley, and Eastward by Lot Number Two hundred & forty Six, Returned into the Secretarys Office the 5th day of August 1774 for Francis Leiby. Warrant dated the 1st August 1774.

IN TESTIMONY that the above is a copy of the original remaining on file in the Department of Internal Affairs of Pennsylvania, made conformably to an Act of Assembly approved the 16th day of February, 1833, I have hereunto set my Hand and caused the Seal of said Department to be affixed at Harrisburg, this ninth day of August 1905.
