



A Plan of a Lot of ground situate on the East side of Water Street and South side of Philadelphia Street in the Town of York, marked on the general Plan of the said Town Number one hundred and thirteen containing in Breadth on Water Street aforesaid Fifty seven Feet and six Inches and in length on Philadelphia Street aforesaid two hundred and Fifty Feet, Bounded Westward with Water Street aforesaid, Northward with Philadelphia Street aforesaid, Eastward with a twenty feet alley and Southward with a lot of ground marked on the Plan aforesaid Number one hundred and fourteen, formerly surveyed and laid out for Michael Ledderman who has built an House thereon according to the Conditions of settling the said Town.

Certified at York the 8<sup>th</sup> day of April 1763.
