



A Plan of a Lot of ground situate on the West side of Beaver Street in the Town of York marked on the general Plan of the said Town Number Ninety nine containing in Breadth on the said Street Fifty seven feet and six Inches and in Length to a twenty feet alley two hundred and fifty Feet Bounded Eastward with Beaver Street aforesaid, Southward with a Lot of ground marked on the said Plan Number one hundred westward with a twenty feet alley and Northward with a Lot of ground marked on the Plan-aforesaid Number Ninety eight formerly surveyed and laid out for Michael Ledderman who has built an House thereon according to the Conditions of settling the said Town.
