



Surveyed on the Eighth Day of March 1733 To Elias Long a Tract of land situate in the Township of of Salford in the County of Philad<sup>a</sup> Begining at a corner of Lodwick Sheffers land thence by the same North West one hundred & forty two perchs to a Black Oak thence by Vacant land North East one hundred & Eighty perches to a White Oak thence by Vacant land South East one hundred and forty two perches to a White Oak in the line of Andreas Hawk's land thence by the same South West one hundred & Eighty perches to ye place of Begining Containing one hundred & fifty acres - with usual allowance.
