



By Virtue of a Warrant the 26<sup>th</sup> day of November 1771 Surveyed  
 the 14<sup>th</sup> June 1772 for Hugh McWilliams one Hundred and Ninety  
 Nine acres and allowance of 6 P. Ct Situate on the waters of Mah-  
 oning Creek now in Northumb<sup>d</sup> County. The above 105<sup>a</sup> & ca. Bound-  
 -ed by the Black lines being the part Returned into the Secretarys  
 Office the 30<sup>th</sup> day of April 1776 for Robert Corry.

IN TESTIMONY that the above is a copy of the original remaining on file in  
 the Department of Internal Affairs of Pennsylvania, made  
 conformably to an Act of Assembly approved the 16th day of  
 February, 1833, I have hereunto set my Hand and caused  
 the Seal of said Department to be affixed at Harrisburg,
