



Situate on a branch of Stony Creek including a part of the Great Glade formerly part in Luemahoning and part in Brothers Valley Township Bedford County - now Stony Creek and Brothers Valley Townships Somerset County - and is part of that tract of land surveyed and returned for Philip Kimmel in right of Richard Wells by Order of Survey No 3522 dated 23^d June 1769 and surveyed 2^d May 1774 - But the said Philip Kimmel having in his lifetime conveyed the above mentioned tract to his sons viz the above named Abraham and David - I have at their request caused the same to be divided into equal parts in order that they may obtain separate and distinct Patents agreeably to the grants of the deceased -
