A Draught of a Tract of Land situate in Southampton Township Franklin County Containing Twenty one acres and sixty five perches and the Usual Allowance of six per cent for Roads, being part of a larger tract of Land of Two hundred and thirty six acres and fifty one perches and Allowance &c which was formerly surveyed in pursuance of two Warrants granted to Robert Long one where of Dated October 22<sup>nd</sup> 1746 the other Dated July 10<sup>th</sup> 1752 Resurveyed and laid off from the other part of this tract for David Gish October 26<sup>th</sup> 1810
