



In Pursuance of a Warrant for 400 acres ^{150 ps} dated the 26th day of February AD 1801 granted to Robert Lee - was surveyed on the fourth day of November AD 1857. The above described tract of land containing 424 acres 84 perches and allowance of six per cent. for roads &c. situated in Hancock Township ^{& north in Erie County} Crawford County, one of the times of making the same Edward McElhinne was residing thereon and there was built a house for the habitation of man, and there appeared to be a wood of ten acres of the land cleared & sowed and in a state of cultivation, ~~and that the same was divided as above stated between~~
