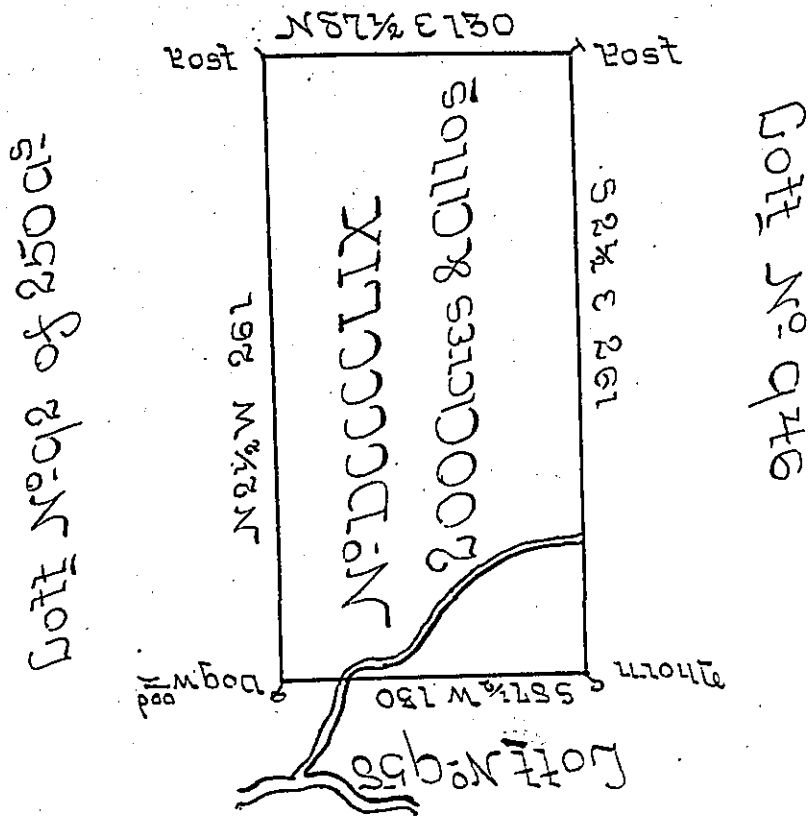

In Pursuance of an Act of General Assembly of the State of Pennsylvania passed the 24th day of February 1755 entitled an Act for directing the mode of distributing the Donation Lands promised the Troops of this Commonwealth and by Order of the Surveyor General with the Approbation of the Hon^{ble} the Executive Council I have surveyed on the 4th day of October 1755 The Above Described Tract of two Hundred Acres of Land with Allowance of six Per Cent for Roads &c No. — situate in District No 5 on the west side of the Allegheny River in Westmoreland County.
