



Situate in Fawn township in the County of York Containing as above set forth 61¹/₂ & 37 ps. and allowance &c. Being part of a larger tract of 192¹/₂ & allowance of land which was originally surveyed by William Kersey late D.S. on the 23^d of the 8th month 1787. In pursuance of a warrant granted to John Livingston bearing date the 2^d day of February A.D. 1787. Resurveyed and divided off from the said larger tract of land on the 25th day of June A.D. 1810 at the request of the present owner John Amos who desired the same to be returned for confirmation.
