A draught of a tract of land surveyed the second day of November 1807 in pursuance of a warrant granted to James Lolley for fifty acres of land dated the 20th day of September 1794 Situate on the waters of Ten Mile Creek in Morris township Washington County called Grape Ridge containing forty four acres & twenty two perches together with six per cent allowance for roads & Highways.
