In pursuance of An Order bearing date Novr 20<sup>th</sup> A. D. 1827 \* Resurveyed the Above described tract of land for the Holland Company on the 22<sup>d</sup> day of Jan<sup>r</sup> 1828. Containing (including the interference With the above Represented No 713) five hundred And fifty four Acres one hundred And thirty eight perches And the Allowance of Six Per Ct & Co. Situate in Red bank township Armstrong County Adjoining Other lands of said Company, land surveyed to Timothy Pickering & Co. lands of John Sloan, And interfering on the West With lands Survey'd to Col. And<sup>W</sup> Porter.
