



The above is a Draught of a Survey made November 4th 1828 in pursuance of a Warrant granted to John Lively, for one hundred and ten Acres of Land, Dated Sept. 15th 1828, Containing but ninety nine Acres, and 78 perches, and Allowance of six per Cent for highways. Situate in Morris Township, W. C. on the head waters of Ten mile Creek on which there is an actual settlement and improvement.
