



By VIRTUE of an application dated the 3<sup>rd</sup> day of April 1769 No. 1522. Surveyed the 9<sup>th</sup> day of July 1772 by William Scull then D.S. unto Michael Roger the above described tract of land situate in Turbut Township Northumberland County on Delaware run containing One hundred and fifty acres & three quarters & the allowas of six per cent &c. and Resurveyed in Part on the 31<sup>st</sup> day of October 1832 agreeably to the old lines & corners as found marked on the ground.
