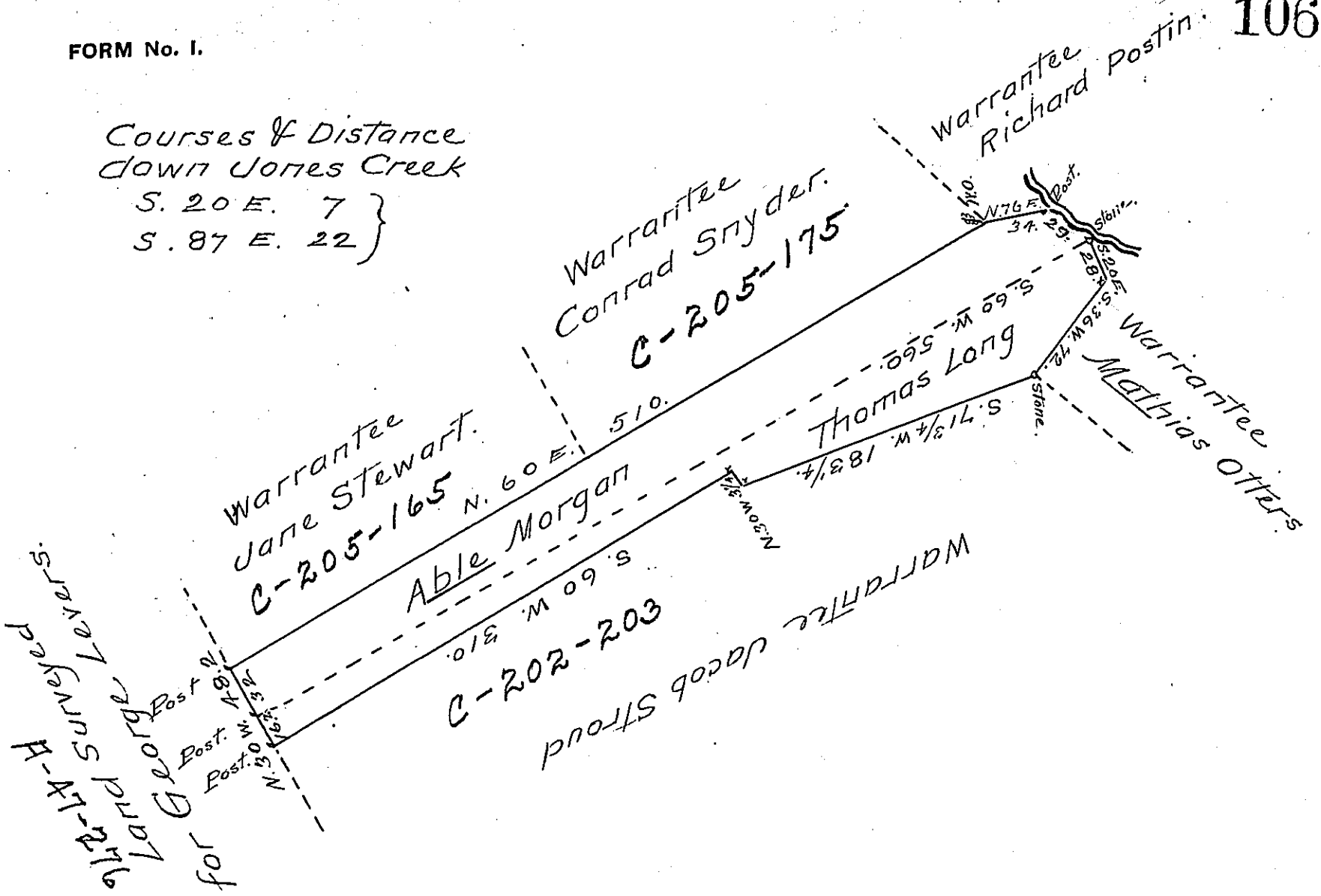

By virtue of two Warrants both dated the 28th day of January 1785 one in the name of Thomas Long, the other in the name of Able Morgan, also both surveyed April 15th 1839 to John Young and John Miller, the above two described Tracts of Land Situate in Lower Smithfield Township - Northampton County (now Pocono Township Monroe County) The one in the name of Thomas Long, Containing one hundred Acres and fifty five perches, The other in the name of Able Morgan, Containing one hundred and two acres & twelve perches & the Allowance of Six Per Cent &c.
