



The above 173 acres and 108 p is part of a tract of land situated on the waters of Sandy Creek in Wharton Township Fayette County and surveyed by John T. Dorsey late Deputy Surveyor in pursuance of a warrant in the name of Workman Lee for 400 acres dated the 10th day of February A D 1794 and resurveyed by me on the 9th day of May 1844. There is about 8 or 10 acres of cleared land on said tract.
