



Situate in Tyrone Township Adams County Being part of a larger tract said to contain 303± of allce. Surveyed Febr^y 17th. 1769 by Arch^d McClean D.S. by warrant to David Leech Dated Sept^r 1st 1749. but now found to contain 309± 10^{ps} of allce. Divided from the residue March 21st 1811 for Peter Anthony containing one hundred & forty acres, one hundred perches of allce.

The Warrant is Dated 1st September 1747.
