No 1 Contains Two hundred and twenty three Acres and twenty perches & Allowence of six per cent for Roads &c. No 2 Contains two hundred & twenty four Acres & sixty nine perches & Allowence of six per cent for Roads &c. Surveyed by for John Lynch on the first and second days of November A. D. 1843 by me.
