The above is a Draft of two Surveys made for John Lynch in pursuance of Actual Settlements and residences haveing long since haveing been made and continued thereon Situate lying and being in Mercer County Sandy Lake Township on the Watters of Sandy creek.

The first Containing one hundred and fifty five Acres and six perches of Allowance of six percent for Roads &c the 2nd Containing three hundred and ninety six Acres and one hundred and forty four Perches of Allowance of six percent For Roads &c As Surveyed for John Lynch on the first & second days of November A.D. 1843 by me.
