The Black lines surveyed agreeably to the Order of the Board which contain one hundred and ninety one Acres and three tenths and allowance &c. Surveyed September 10th 1789 on Warrant granted to Asher Layton Dated May 7th 1787 for 200 Acres of Land in Bethel Township Bedford County.
