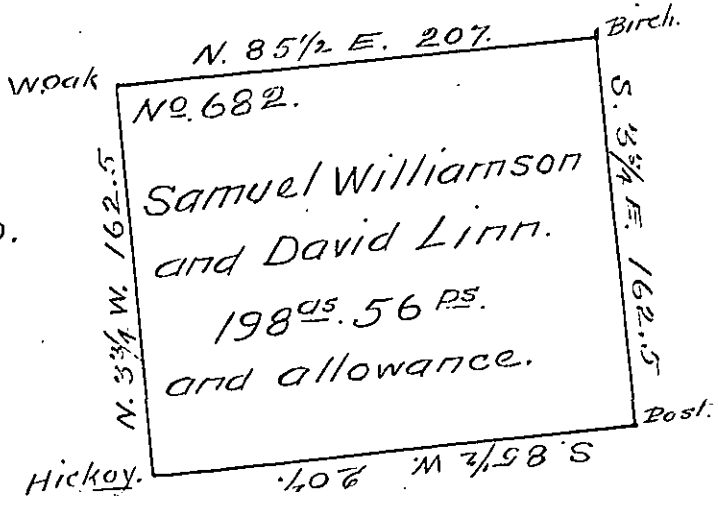

In pursuance of the actual settlement residence and improvement of David Linn, who was residing on said tract with his family at the time of surveying containing one hundred and ninety eight acres and fifty six perches and allowance for roads six percent surveyed for S. Williamson and David Linn. Improvement is much more than is required by law.
