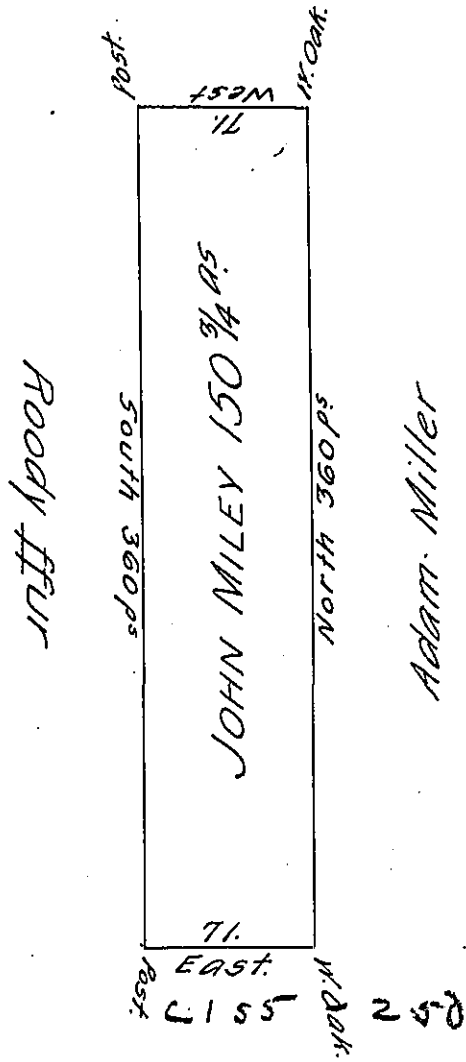

By Virtue of a Warrant from ye Prop<sup>rs</sup> bearing date ye 25<sup>th</sup> of february ~~1734~~  
 1734, Survey'd unto John Miley on the 27<sup>th</sup> of the Same Month, a Tract of  
 Land Situate on a Branch of Conestogo Creek in Lancaster County. Begining  
 at a post at a Corner of Roody ffur's Land, then by the Same South 360<sup>ps</sup> to a  
 post, thence East by Vacant Land 71<sup>ps</sup> to a White Oak, thence North by Adam  
 Miller's Land 360<sup>ps</sup> to another White Oak, thence West 71<sup>ps</sup> to the place of Be-  
 gining. Containing 150<sup>3/4</sup> acres and the allowance of Six  $\frac{1}{2}$  Cent.
