By Virtue of a Warr^t from the Hon^{ble} Proprietaries bearing Date the Second Day of february Anno Dom. 1737. I have Survey'd and Laid out unto Robt Mills in the Township of Pennsborough in the County of Lancaster on the West Side of Susquehanna River. Two hundred & Sixty Acres of Land, With allowance of 6% Cent.

Beginning at a Chestnut a Corner of William Bayly's Land Thence by the Same Land North Twenty Degrees Easterly Two hundred and forty pches to a White Oak a Corner of William Coopers Land Thence North Seventy Degrees Westerly One hundred Seventy and Seven pches to a post a Corner of Patrick Cassons Land. Thence South Twenty Degrees Westerly Two hundred and Sixty pches to a white Oak. Thence South Seventy Six Degrees and ^{and} a half Easterly one hundred and Seventy Eight pches to the place of Beginning. Surveyd March 28th 1738.
