



Situate in Allegheny Township, Huntingdon County, first Surveyed in pursuance of a Warrant Granted to John Baynton & Samuel Wharton, dated the 28<sup>th</sup> day of July 1766, it then contained four hundred and nineteen acres and the usual Allowance.

This part contains three hundred and ninety three Acres, 32 perches, & allowance and was re-surveyed and divided from the residue of said tract on the 29<sup>th</sup> day of May 1822
