



By Virtue of a Warrant from the Proprietor Dated the 22^d Day of April Anno Dom. 1738, the above Described tract of Land was Surveyed unto Rees Morgan in Erie township in Lancaster County. Begining at a Black Oak at a Corner of the Land of Jenkin Jenkin, then South 10 Degrees West by the Same 42 pches &c Containing two Hundred and fifteen Acres beside the Allowance of Six 1/2 Cent. Sur^d 29th of November 1740. *Sam^l Lightfoot* — —
