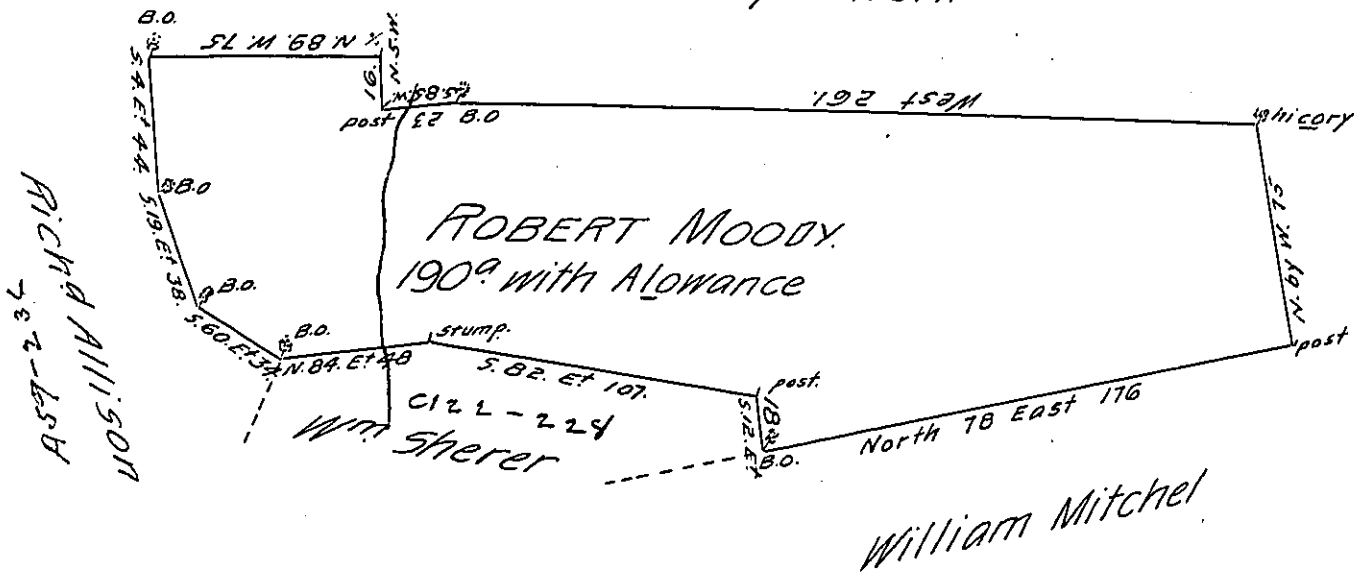

By Order of the Proprietor, Surveyed to Robert Moody A Tract of Land in KOB (1) Township of Donegal & County of Lancaster Beginning at a Black Oak a Corner of William Sherer's Land, thence North 78 deg East 176 per. to a post, thence North by West 75 per. to a hickory, thence West 261 per. to a Black Oak, thence South 85 deg. West 23 per. to a post, thence North 5 deg. West 16 per. to a post, thence North 89 deg. West 75 per. to a Black Oak, thence South 4 deg. East 44 per. to a Black Oak, thence South 19 deg. East 38 per. to a Black Oak, thence South 60 deg. East 34 per. to a Black Oak, thence North 84 deg. East 48 per. to a Stump, thence South 82 deg. East 107 per. to a post, thence South 12 deg. East 18 per. to the place of Beginning. Containing One Hundred & Ninety Acres with the Usual Allowance of Six Acres  $\frac{7}{8}$  Cent for Roads &c.
