McConnell, bearing date the 17<sup>th</sup> day of Jan<sup>y</sup>. 1785.

N°2, Being a tract of Land situate in Letterkenny Township, afforesaid, containing One hundred & nine acres & sixty nine perches & allowance; and is part of a larger tract of Land which was surveyed and laid off by Daniel Henderson, Esq. late Deputy Surveyor (on the 4<sup>th</sup> Nov<sup>r</sup>. 1801.) or in pursuance of a Warrant granted to Andrew Boggs, bearing date the 23<sup>rd</sup> day of August 1784. As appears by the Official drafts thereof, remaining in my Office, which drafts I have examined and find correct.
