D. 1793. Mr. Hollenback showed me all his title to the above land; his leading, is in the name of Hannah Stone dated 28th Aug^t 1792, and the pond men- tioned in 5th Warrant is nearly two miles from the above described land. And another War- rant in the name of Nathan Waller, Jun^r of the same date, is near four miles from the above described land.
