Granted to Henry Kunkel and dated the 14th day of April 1803. & now on the 17th day of December A.D. 1839 Draughted the above and Returned the same into the Surveyor General's office, at Harrisburg, at the Request of Elisabeth Kunkel the present owner, who is intermarried with the said Samuel Ehrman, who wish to Patent the same &c.
