



By virtue of a Warrant dated the 23^d day of June 1785. No 583 the above described tract of Land containing four hundred acres & the usual allowance of six P. Cent &c^o Situate on the Road leading from the Mouth of Andersons Creek to Lake Erie, about seven Miles from the said Mouth, in Clearfield County there was Surveyed for Andrew Keis said tract on the 25th day of April 1793 by James Hunter formerly deputy Surveyor, "for last purchase district No 4."
