



A Draught of a Tract of land situate in Williams Township Northampton County, the Plank lines Represents one of the Tracts Returned to George Palmer late Deputy by the late Surveyor general agreeable to an act passed the 26 march 1820, Directing the Recovery of the Money Due the Commonwealth from Persons holding lands under the Proprietary Government original Surveyed to Michael Kough by warrant of the 16 March 1747 for 148 a 113 p.

By virtue of the above warrant Surveyed the 3rd day of September 1846 the above described Tract of land containing four acres and eighty perches and the allowance to John Russel in Right of the said Michael Kough, being part of the above mentioned Tract.
