



Situate in North Codorus Township, in the County of York, Containing as above set forth 31 as & 18 perches & allowance &c. Being the same Land, which was originally surveyed by William Mathews late D.S. on the 6th day of the 11th mo 1772 for Barnet Ziegler and Jacob Walter, in trust for the use of a Lutherian Congregation, in pursuance of a Warrant for 50 as granted to Frederick Kuhn, bearing date the 1st day of August 1766, Resurveyed by the old settled lines of the present adjoiners on the 26th day of April A.D. 1839, for and at the request of the Elders & others of said Congregation, who Requested me to make return of the same for Confirmation, who wish to Patent the same to Daniel Diehl and Philip Gertzler and to their Successors, But in trust as aforesaid
