



By Virtue of a warrant for twenty-five acres granted to John Kline and Barnard Kline the 4th day of January 1786 surveyed the 2d of August 1837 the above described Tract of Land, unto Thomas Craig, the present owner thereof situate in Towamensing township in the County of Northampton Containing Seven acres, an hundred and thirty-five perches and the allowance of six per cent for roads &c. (Being a part of the land originally surveyed by virtue of the above recited Warrant the 14th of February 1786.)
