



A Draught of a Tract of Land called the Elbow Situate on the Raystown Branch of Juniata a small distance above a Tract of Land said to be Surveyed for Samuel Perry Esq. and a small distance below and on the opposite side of the River from a Tract of Land Surveyed to John Cunningham, in Barre Township in the County of Bedford containing thirty eight Acres and the Usual Allowance of Six Per Cent for Roads &c. Surveyed the 10th Day of June 1771 for John Livingston in pursuance of a Warrant granted to him the 13th Day of December 1770.
