Being part of a larger Tract containing two hundred and twenty one acres and allowance which was Surveyed on the 5<sup>th</sup> day of the 5<sup>mo</sup> 1772 to William Love on his Warrant dated the 27<sup>th</sup> day of March Anno Dom. 1744. Certified the 16<sup>th</sup> day of August 1809.
