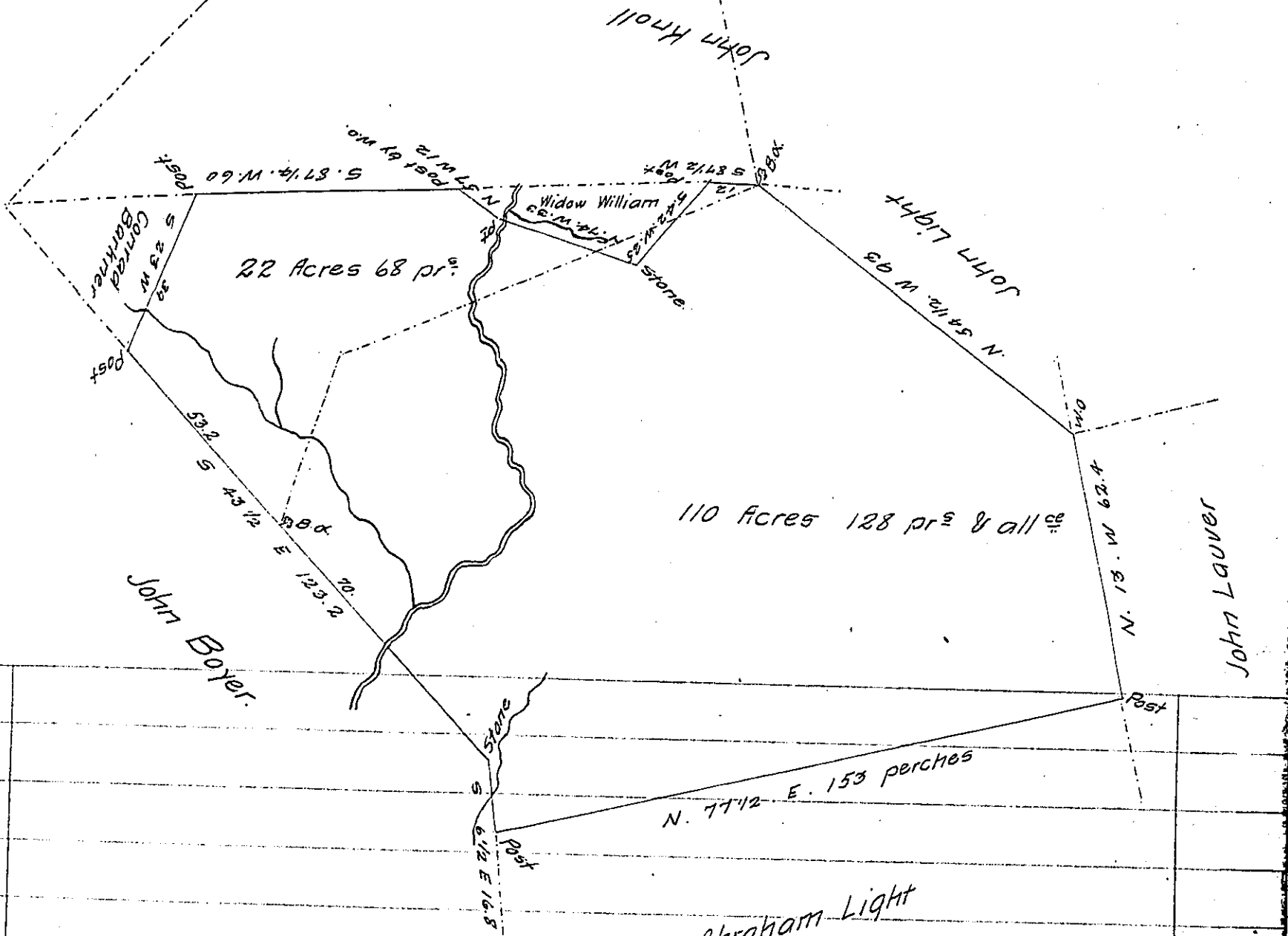

Abraham Light

Surveyed April 9th 1813 for John Light the above described tracts of land situate in Lebanon Township Dauphin County to wit: Twenty two Acres sixty eight perches & Allowance of 6 per Cent part of One hundred five Acres One hundred forty nine perches & allowance aforesaid on Warrant of Gabriel Lemly dated January 3^d 1752. — and One hundred ten Acres One hundred twenty eight perches the greater part of a larger tract found now to contain One hundred Eleven Acres twenty eight perches & all^{ce} aforesaid on Warrant of Herman Orndorf dated the 15 February 1753.
