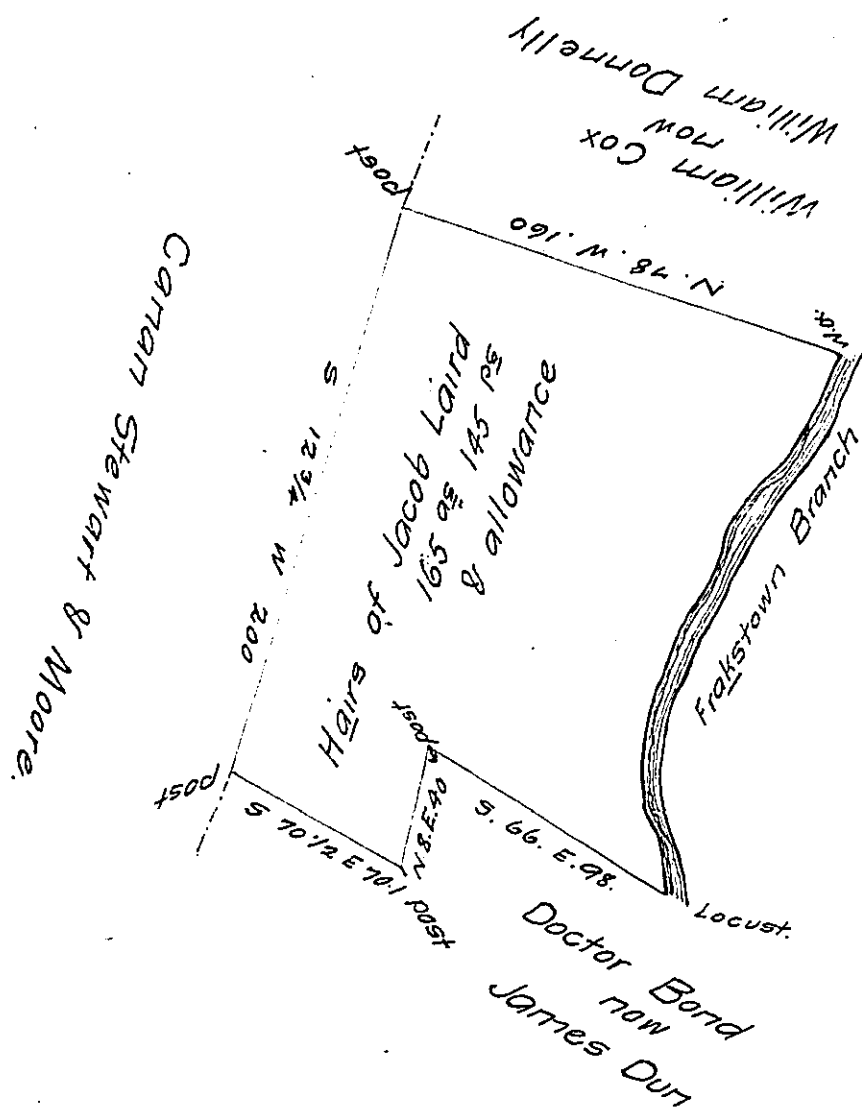


D Courses down the river from the Locust to the Whiteoak.
