



A Draught of a tract of land called ——— Situate in Penns township
 Union County (formerly Northumberland.) Surveyed the second day of
 September Anno Domini One thousand eight hundred and eleven by
 Thomas Woodsides the then deputy Surveyor by Virtue of an Order of
 resurvey bearing date at Lancaster the third day of June A.D. One
 thousand eight hundred and eleven granted unto Jacob Lechner in right
 of Michael Swengel by Virtue of his Warrant bearing date the eighth day of
 December A.D. One thousand seven hundred and eighty seven. And resur-
 vey the tenth day of June A.D. One thousand eight hundred and fourteen
 containing Forty nine Acres and One hundred and twenty one perches
 and the Usual Allowance of six P Cent for roads &c.
